

# Alcorn School-wide Behavior Incentive System

## Alcorn Mentoring Program

- Established a school culture of acceptance, tolerance and respect.
- Targeted students have been assigned mentors who meet with them weekly to discuss academic and behavioral goals.

## PBIS

- School Wide Behavior Incentive System “Alcorn Bucks”. Students will receive “Alcorn Bucks” for demonstrating positive behavior reflecting the “Alcorn Bee’s”



### Be appropriate

- demonstrate appropriate behavior inside/outside of your classroom



### Be respectful

- to all staff in Language & actions



### Be responsible

- follow all directions
- no disciplinary referrals (destroying school property, walking out of class,
- fighting or suspensions)



### Be your best

- do your best work in all classes (no more than one missed assignment)

This system is centered around student accountability.

This system requires a joint effort by all staff members in determining a student rating (this will help students to understand that appropriate behavior is expected by every staff member in every area throughout the day).

There is a display on all floors, where all student ratings will be tracked weekly (using a red/yellow/green system).

Each floor will have an “Alcorn Bucks” display.

Amounts will be posted next to each child’s name.

Students will receive Alcorn Bucks daily and will be able to cash them in for incentives.

- Weekly staff meetings are held to train and enforce a positive school climate.
- School-wide assemblies to promote the message of acceptance and that Universal Alcorn Charter Elementary School is a “Bully-free School.”

Encouraged students to “say something when they see something” through classroom guidance lessons. Encouraged the students to be more than a “bystander.”

- Classroom Guidance lessons and bulletin board displays on:
  - “Being a Bucket Filler”
  - “Self-esteem”
  - “Character Education”
- Bully prevention and Expectation posters displayed around the school, to serve as constant reminders to our students.
- Individual and group counseling sessions/mediation while conflicts arise.
- Reinforce positive social interactions and inclusiveness through constant conversation and monitoring.
