

Is your family temporarily staying in:

- A hotel, weekly-rate housing, or campground because nothing else is available to you?
- A shelter (family, domestic violence, or transitional living?)
- Housing with no electricity, water, and/or heat?
- Doubled up with other people due to loss of housing or economic hardship?



Yes?

Your children may have the right to receive services and support in school under the Federal McKinney-Vento Act and Pennsylvania State Law.

Your children have the right to:

- Enroll in school immediately, even if lacking documents normally required for enrollment.
- Stay in the same school, even if you move, and receive free transportation to and from that school if it is in their best educational interest.
- College readiness assistance for high school students.
- Connecting younger children to early childhood services.
