- Doubled up with other people due to loss of housing, economic hardship, being kicked out or running away from home?

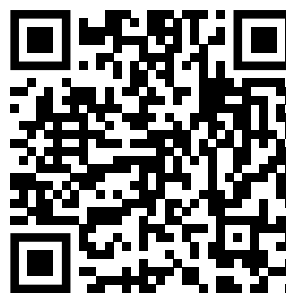


Yes?

Make sure you **know your rights** to receive services and support in your school under the Federal McKinney-Vento Act and Pennsylvania State Law.

You have the right to:

- Enroll in school and attend classes immediately, even if lacking documents normally required for enrollment.
- Stay in the same school, even if you move, and receive free transportation to and from that school if it is in your best educational interest.
- Participate fully in all school activities and programs.
- Help planning for college and post-secondary opportunities.
